

DIRECTIONS TO GROUNDS

FROM THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 4, ROUTE 150
AND COUNTY LINE ROAD (between Cutler and Percy):

Travel south on Route 4 approximately 1 mile
Turn left on Pyatt-Cutler Road
Travel approximately 5.5 miles east on Pyatt-Cutler Rd
Turn left at the black top road entrance—just opposite the Denmark
park sign (on right) . Pass through the yellow gate, turning left
when you get to the barn road. Parking lot is on the right.**

Note that Park Headquarters are east of the field trial area.

Horse Barn stalls are on first come basis, with judges stalls mrked. Horse stake out
area on east side of parking lot.

**Camping on grounds available based on IDNR fees. Field trial secretary will
collect fees. Overflow parking available on the Denmark Unit. Water & electric
available on both sides.
