



Remy



Good afternoon. My name is Jason Waterbury, and in September 2007, I took home a liver and white pup from your kennel, and we named him Remy. Remy was my first ever "bird dog", and I was new to upland game bird hunting. Unfortunately, my wife became pregnant right before we took Remy home, so in the craziness of life, properly training a bird dog probably didn't happen. However, I did what we could.

Long story short, the first 2 years or so of hunting were rough (had major problems bumping birds), but then around the age of 3 or 4...the light bulb went off in Remy's brain. He started really "hunting". The moment that I knew I had something special was around age 3 or 4. I was hunting at my gun club, and Remy had "gotten birdy". Problem was, it was in small patch of hard woods, where he typically struggled as he could "see" the birds. All of the sudden, he locks up on point. I look about 10 yards in front of him and there is a hen sitting in a tree stump that was partially hollowed out. The problem in this situation, was that the opening of the tree stump was in front of Remy....so the only place the bird could go was straight towards us. As I stood there for a second or two trying to figure out my plan, something magical happened. While holding his point, Remy pivoted counter clockwise around the tree stump increasing his distance slightly as if he didn't want to disturb the bird. Once I noticed this I followed suit. Once we were behind the bird, I was able to flush and shoot it.

It was in this moment that I knew Remy had "figured it out". He was an amazing dog, and in his prime, from ages 5-11, we probably took home 20-25 birds a season. There were a dozen or so instances where he and I walked into an area and were approached by empty handed hunters telling me there "are no birds in there", only to have him point 2 or 3. He was an amazing dog, and I couldn't have asked for a better hunting dog to learn to hunt with, and have as part of our family.

Unfortunately, on April 26th, of this year, we had to put him down. He had been fighting a very aggressive cancer, and was losing the battle. I still miss him immensely to this day. He would have been 15 this past Saturday. I wanted to say Thank You for breeding such an amazing dog. I don't remember both his parents' names, but I believe his dad was "Henry".

Temperament

According to the new edition of Merriam-Webster, definition for the word temperament is as follows:

- Characteristic or habitual inclination or mode of emotional response,
- Excessive sensitiveness or irritability; of character, personality, and makeup.

This author often uses the dictionary to define/study a specific word being the subject of an article. Result often is nothing but confusion. In this instance let's just move forward with the word temperament.

Often in the dog world one hears the term for temperament -- the dog is biddable; easily trained. Biddable defined as "obedient, docile, which is termed a dog easily taught.

The American Kennel Club (AKC) has established a department within their organization, which specifically focuses on temperament. This group rates many breeds with regard to temperament. AKC has a test, used for their descriptive rating. The Brittany's temperament description is a breed that is "happy and alert; upbeat and neither mean or shy".

The AKC description has left out from this author's viewpoint, the Brittany is affectionate, docile, easy to train, eager to please, and is a great family dog. After having the Brittany in our house-hold for almost 50 years, there probably is a bit of prejudice.

Although if one discusses the breed with others, the comment often is "the Brittany is a breed with 'high energy and needs lots of exercise". From my own experience, it is probably sometimes the case. However, this is one of the characteristics of a Brittany that can be improved. It starts at a very age. During the first week after pups have been whelped and within a day or two after tails have been docked and dewclaws removed.

Talk to Mom Brittany and gently pick up pups one at a time, hold it, snuggle with pup; repeat couple times a day.

After a few days, while holding snuggling, invert and turn pup on its back. It will probably cry; stroke the head and belly gently. In a few days pup will be ok being turn. This is the very beginning of socialization process. Repeated contact most every day is extremely important in the development of this young Brittany pup. As pup's eyes and ears open to sight and sound, which occurs in 10 to 15 days; it becomes aware of a "new world". This time is also important to continue the human contact. Pup's Mom may show concern for pup being removed from

the "den" and pup's litter mates; just calmly reassure her "everything is alright". As pup matures on thru the process of being weaned between five to six weeks, this human contact and socialization is necessary to achieve the desired calm temperament. At their young age pups ability to be absorb information is unbelievable -- their like a sponge. Kids – neighbor and grandchildren—do a great job of providing that human contact. Undoubtedly genetics has an affect; however, techniques described do have an effect on Brittany pups. It has been observed in our household with the 16 litters over those 50 years. Breeding has changed over the years with now a focus on temperament and improving the characteristics of the Brittany. The breeding has been done with a specific male and female; most often artificial, because the male, who had achieved during his life a worthy record, has been deceased.

Our breeding program has never lost sight of the fact that a major number of those people who purchase a pup want it to be a new member of the family. A fair number of those folks may bird hunt. The minority of those Brittanys will be purchased for competition – agility, show, and field trials.

It's been almost a life-time spent with the Brittany. It's been an adventure with the Brittany, who has created many memories. With the next installment, hopefully this author will share with you some of those memories and the influence that our Brittanys have had with the bred. Thank you from this author for being able to share with you the reader these adventures.



The following stories and cartoons have been reprinted from a manuscript that was intended to become a published book. This work was titled "BITS ABOUT BRITTANIES" and was written by Clarence Goering from Newton, Kansas. Clarence bought his first Brittany in 1942 it was a male he named Marquette Allamuchy. He was very active with Brittanies from that point until the 1960's. Being an active, well-known breeder during that era his kennel "TRIUMPH BRITTANIES" was nationally sponsored by Ralston Purina feed company. A copy of this manuscript was assembled into book form and is on display at the Brittany Field Trial Hall of Fame museum in Grand Junction, TN.

A Nebraska Hunt

During the years, I made several very successful hunting trips into Nebraska. One time, my brother Al and his son-in-law Clay, had an invitations to bring me and my dogs along too. So I took Marke and Buck.

This proved to be an interesting hunt from several angles. We started our hunt in a corn field. As we were walking through the field, I noticed two hens that flushed quite a distance ahead of us. When we came to the end of the field, Al's friend said to me, "Can you make you dogs heel? I think they might be getting to far ahead of us and flushing the birds." I answered, "Yes, I could make them heel, but I want them to hunt and I'll put them back in the car rather than make them heel all the time."

While we were standing there, Marke and Buck were in the end of the field and suddenly a big cock flushed right out of the end of the corn row Al's friend had just walked. This so surprised Al's friend that he just stood there and didn't even raise his gun to shoot. When I saw this, I threw gun up to my shoulder and got off a hurried shot. By that time the bird was out there along way, but I hit him hard and he started to fall. The dogs saw him going down and started after him. He finally hit the ground and started running, so by the time the dogs caught him, they were about a quarter of a mile away from us. Marke caught the bird and brought it all the way back to us, much to the amazement of Al's friend, who after this, made no more mention of having the dogs heel.

As we were walking to the car, another cock flushed wild, the dogs had not caused the flush. As the cock flew across the road, he hit an electric line wire and fell to the ground with a broken wing. We went to where he had fallen, but the dogs couldn't find him in the ditch. So I suggested that we make a circle in the corn field across the road to see if he might have run into it. Sure enough, after we had walked about a block in the corn field, I heard Buck running through the corn stalks and in just no time he came to me carrying the bird with the broken wing. This further amazed Al's friend.

When hunting in a corn field, I have formed the habit of calling out hup-hup. This is to remind the dogs of my where abouts, so they will hunt in front of me. Well, by this afternoon, I heard Al's friend call out hup-hup. So I said to him, "The dogs are both working here in front of me." He replied, "I know that, but I want them to come over and work in front of me."

So evening came. We had a good hunt. We got the limit of birds for the four of us and everyone, including Marke and Buck, had a good day.

Slim Saves the Day

Roy, Harry, and I were hunting quail in Southeast Kansas. There were lots of quail that year, so by noon we needed to shoot only three more birds to fill our limit. As we were eating lunch, the thought came to me and I said, "You know, since we need only three more birds to fill our limit, I think we could start home after we have finished eating. I'm just sure we will see some birds along the road some place and we can get our last three birds then." Roy and Harry agreed, so we started for home after finishing our lunch.

Kansas Hunts

We hadn't driven but a few miles and were driving on a road which had a hedgerow on one side. Suddenly, Roy said, "Stop! Stop! I just saw a cock quail sitting on top of an old 5 gallon can laying beside a hedge tree." I stopped the car a little ways down the road, but I said, "If you saw a cock sitting on an old can, he is the lookout, so there must be a whole covey of birds." Roy was convinced that there was only one bird, so he and Harry hurried back to the spot where he had seen the bird. As they came to the spot, a whole covey of quail exploded out of the ditch. Roy and Harry each dropped a bird, so I let my dog Slim out of the crate to make the retrieves.

The birds flew down the road and landed in the ditch about two block away. So we started to walk to where they had dropped, thinking we would get our last bird. The birds had landed in the ditch on the north side of the road, but there was a farmer living on the south side. He had some cattle in a feed lot and he was out among them. When we approached, he came over to the fence and said he would appreciate it if we didn't do anymore shooting because he had recently bought the cattle and they were a bit spooky, so they might break out if scared by the shooting.

We told him that we didn't want to cause any trouble and wouldn't shoot anymore. As we started to return to the car, I looked and there was Slim on point where the birds had landed. I knew I couldn't call Slim off point, so I went to flush the birds, When I stepped beside Slim, the birds flushed. One flushed right toward Slim and he jumped in the air, hitting the bird with one of his front feet. The bird was knocked to the ground and before it could recover its flight, he pounced on it. He picked it up and brought it to me wagging his tail all the way.

That gave us our last bird, but none of us could hardly believe what had happened. What a memory on which to end the day's hunt.

2022 MID AMERICA BRITTANY CLASSIC

2022 was the first running of the MID AMERICA BRITTANY CLASSIC. This event had been run for several years as a Championship. The association of the American Field and American Kennel Club is planned to be different with this event in the future. So, the planning committees for the event thought why not start this year. This was the start of the Mid America Brittany Classic and was held April 25-27, 2022 at the Branched Oak Field Trial Area near Raymond, Nebraska. The Mid American Brittany Classic (GLOAA) was hosted by the Missouri Valley Brittany Club and followed the regional club event held April 22-24, 2022. All events only followed the rules of the American Kennel Club.

There are some fine folks we need to mention for their contribution to the success of this Mid America Brittany Classic. First and foremost, Bill and Julie Cockrum along with Bruce Heiter who are club members of the Missouri Valley Brittany Club. Wesley Felt, from Texas, was there to report and Marshall the running. Bill planted birds and did the dog wagon. This year Bill used a side-by-side ATV as a dog wagon. It really did improve the availability of distribution and retrieval of the dogs.

The Branched Oak Field Trial Area has a large lodge for socializing and lunches. Missouri Valley Brittany Club members provided lunch for the participants. The sponsor for the 2022 Mid America Brittany Classic is Nestle Purina. Nestle Purina gives both money toward the running of this event and Pro Plan products for the winners. Purina is fed to several dogs running in this event as testimony to the quality of feed used in the Pro Plan dog products. We thank our sponsor for their continued support.

I would like to write a few words about SNIKSOH WORTHY EXPENSE, owned by a dear friend Jeff Hoskins. Field Champion SNIKSOH WORTHY EXPENSE competed on Friday in the Open All Age. He broke away and ran a line that took him away from Jeff. SNIKSOH WORTHY EXPENSE was considered lost and Jeff tracked him to where he was found lifeless. His life was hunting in field trials as he began winning as a pup and was the winner 2019 Central futurity All Age. He was a Field Champion early in his career and less than five years old died doing what he loved doing; running in a field trial. Our thoughts are with Jeff and his family for their loss.

The judges for this year's event were Rodney Albin from Missouri and Dan Voss from Minnesota. These two judges were up to the task of three days of riding to select the true all age competitors. The judges had a number of good dogs to choose from with training to run an hour with all-age range, and intensity on birds pointed to be named as the WINNER.

Branched Oak Field Trial Area provides ample space to show a true all age bird dog. We had 34 dogs go to the line in this year's Classic. The Classic is a one hour continuous course with six braces per day.

The Winner named for the 2022 Mid America Brittany Classic was SIGRITBRIT'S NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE, owned by Nick Blasi from Kansas and handled by Scott Johnson of Kansas. Her sire is GFC/FC/AFC SNIKSOH SPANK'S HANK and dam is FC/AFC MK'S MY LIL AMMO. This has been a great two weeks at Branched Oak Field Trial Grounds for SIGRITBRIT'S NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE as she was also named Winner of the Nebraska Brittany Grand Limited Open All Age run the week before.

This got me thinking, since 2014 when I began reporting for both clubs, has this ever occurred before. I found several dogs that had placed in both events but my records does not show another dog awarded Winner in the same year for both Grand Limited Open All Age events held at Branched Oak Trial Grounds. Congratulation to this winning team! Second place was SNIKSOH HANK'S HATCH.

The third place was awarded to BAMA JAMA WILLY'S SASSIE SADIE. Owned by Wayne Pepin from Indiana and handled by Bob Burchett from Iowa. Her sire is HOPE'S CHIEF OF CROSSCREEK and dam is WILD MTN'S MIDNIGHT

What's the Score?

Every healthy dog ever born comes preprogrammed with all the skills we need them to perform in order to be a bird dog. It's all there, from birth. They can walk, run, stop, smell, carry stuff in their mouths, stand still, work as part of a team or pack, and they have the instinctive desire to hunt and find game. It's not unlike the software loaded on your computer or cell phone. It's all installed. The difficult part is us. We humans have to learn how to run the program and adapt it to our needs. Some folks are computer wizards and it comes easily, while others have to work pretty hard to figure it out and make it work. Dog training isn't much different. Some are naturals and others struggle to make any kind of sense of it. Either way, it doesn't really matter as long as you can do one thing - just one thing - really well.

You have to be absolutely consistent. And we mean every single time you do something with your dog, you have to both do it the same way and expect the same result, making corrections as needed to assure that result. Of course, there is always some room for some slack as learning happens - there will be errors and corrections - but the important thing is making that progress. That won't happen if you aren't consistent in your actions and your expectations.

A simple example would be calling your dog to you. What we usually hear is something like this: "Here! HERE! C'mon, let's go, get over here, come here." Way too much word salad happening right there. Use one word, said in the same tone and the same way, every single time. Adjusting volume is fine if conditions require more than quiet, but leave the emotion out. Be consistent. Be the same. Let your dog trust you to always be the same leader in the same way. You're helping the dog form a habit, and it works best if things happen in a consistent manner.

What does being consistent have to do with keeping score? Let's use the example of letting your dog out of the crate in your vehicle (or house, or kennel, etc.; any door will do). It should happen something like this: You open the crate door. Dog remains where he is in the crate until you invite him to come forward and through the door. The dog comes out and stands still on the tailgate. You put the lead on and invite the dog to come to heel on the ground and by your side. The dog does exactly that and stands still, waiting for further instructions. Nice and controlled, right? That happens every time for five times in a row.

The sixth time,

you're in a hurry, the dog senses that and is excited, jumps to through the door and onto the ground without following the usual routine of cues. You're in a rush so you let it go, just that one time. Score? Owner 5, Dog 1. We can promise you the dog will try the same thing the next time if you aren't prepared to stop it. New score? Owner 5, Dog 2.

The first time the dog bolted through the door you should have grabbed the dog, put him back in the crate, and corrected the misbehavior and made him follow the routine you've trained. The few seconds that took would have stopped this from becoming part of a new behavior pattern. Being in a hurry is no excuse for allowing sloppy habits to creep in.

If a dog can't control his enthusiasm enough to stand still and wait for your permission to move while waiting at a kennel door or crate door, what are the odds he will remain standing steady on point during the excitement of a hunt? All the little day-to-day details are what help set you and the dog up for success in the field.

Speaking of hunting, what happens if your dog breaks? What should you do? If you've done your training on birds at home, your dog has a solid understanding of what *whoa* means and has been corrected for chasing. His rookie season will set the stage for the rest of his life, so think of that first season as the place you'll do a little less shooting and a little more educating.

If you allow your dog to et away with breaking and chasing when hunting, you are training the dog to do just that. There is absolutely nothing wrong

She is an avid hunter and archer, and in her spare time is working on the first of a series of books on bird dog training with Rick Smith. with running the dog with the flank collar if you are more confident doing so, and that gives you a good way to enforce the lesson about standing steady and not bumping and chasing birds. Nothing we can do in training will recreate the excited atmosphere of a real hunting scenario, so carrying the *whoa* training into that first season is generally a wise move. Correct when you need to correct, even if it means letting a shot opportunity pass. Remember, your dog is keeping score just like he does at home, so don't let things slide. You teach what you allow.

Part of training and thinking about keeping score begins with never letting your dog know he has any other option outside of what you want and expect. Dogs will always try to repeat something they like or want. That works out great when it happens to also be what you want them to do, but it's not so great when they try something you don't want but get away with doing it anyway. One more point goes on the dog's scorecard, and he will try to score again on that same behavior because he has figured out that there is more than one option. Eliminate all options except the one you want. Anticipate your dog's response so you can stop any deviations from what you want.

It's not how many times your dog does something;

it's how many times he does it correctly. If you do an exercise 10 times and six of those are what you want but four are incorrect, that's too close to an even score. That needs to be done in perspective of course, because there will be errors when first teaching a skill. If the four incorrect times are early on and the six good ones come at the end, quit there and call it good because you're on the right track. When you come back to try it again, accept nothing less than those six good ones and be prepared to stop any attempt at a mistake.

Be clear, concise, and consistent. That will help your dog to understand what you want and develop the good habits you're after. Remember, you're always keeping score and so is your dog. He will look for the easy way out, and that can work for you as long as you make the right thing be the easy way and the wrong thing be the difficult way.

The end goal is to always keep the dog's side of the scoreboard as close to a shutout as you can. Sure, he is going to gain a point or two every so often, but you should be far enough ahead that those are negligible. Anticipate potential behavior and errors, keep it fun for the dog, and you'll have a dog ready and willing to hit the field this fall.



Button

The very first dog I ever had was our family dog a Brittany we called "Zipper". I was about 3rd grade when we got the puppy. My Dad wanted to hunt pheasants in Ohio, which is why he chose a Brittany for our first pet. All we kids knew about that was: number one, they always brought home birds; number two, Dad always came home boasting that his dog had the best nose of any kind of dog out there; and number three, that we weren't allowed to go with him. Zip was a great family pet and kept all of us kids hopping. He was always ready to tow us by a rope on our bikes and ready for a game of "keep away" whenever he got loose

in the neighborhood. He was the best "keep away-er" and catching him was a challenge. We eventually learned to throw ourselves on the ground and pretend to cry, and he would come to our rescue. Seemed kind of mean to fool him like that sometimes, but at least we could catch him that way.

Fast forward 60 years, and after many years of dogs of all types-mainly rescues-I consider myself an experienced dog person. Now retired from my career, I decided it's time for me to have another Brittany. When I found there was an excellent breeder not ten miles away from me here in Florida I was amazed and delighted, and I knew it was time. I took my Dad, who was 90 then, out to visit the kennel and he just beamed and bragged about

Zip like he did when he was a young man. It was a happy day. I put down a deposit and waited for a litter. I wanted a liver-colored female since Zip was orange and a male, and I wanted to avoid comparing her to Zip. I really wanted one of each, but I still have a young rescue dog and an older, crotchety terrier who I didn't think would appreciate two more puppies, so, I can wait.

After what seemed like forever, the day finally came and I got my Button! I got to pick her out of a very large litter and knew it was her the second I picked her up. Her eyes were not even open yet. Some things you just know instantly. Not for one minute have I been at all disappointed in this puppy. I call the Brittany a "double dog"; they do everything twice as fast, work twice as hard, play twice as hard, love twice as much, are double the fun and can be double the mischief. She was pointing when she was only 9 weeks old, and I was a little worried that I would not be able to find a way to meet her hunting needs, which is so obviously in her DNA. As it turned out, she took care of that herself. She's 9 months old now and grew up with a 15 year old terrier I call Bandit, who now can't see or hear very well. When I call her these days I pretty much have to go look for her and put myself where she can see me. Well, of course, Button was on the hunt with

me when I'd go to find Bandit. I really didn't consider that I was actually teaching her to look for Bandit until suddenly, one day when I went out and called for Bandit, I saw Button looking and sniffing. When she found her, she started barking at her. At first I said to myself, "Nah, she's not really doing this." But she did it again and again. Often, Bandit is under the house where I would never find her. Well, that Button can find her wherever she is, and she does. Thank you, Button!

I thought that was pretty amazing until she hunted something else up for me. One day, she was just out digging in the yard. She does bury stuff sometimes, but this was an obsessive digging for some reason. I was out working somewhere on the other side

of the house, so after I told her to quit, I just went about my business. So did she. She went back to the business of digging that hole. When I came back by, there was a big hole in the yard about two and a half feet deep down into wet dirt. What the heck? I looked into the hole, and she had exposed the fact that my septic transfer casing had collapsed and there was only a matter of time before it got a lot worse. My son-in-law came out and did "whatever it was" to fix it, and said she could have saved me thousands of dollars in having to replace the leach field. Thanks again, Button! She's not even a year old and already my hero.
