

2022 ABC Open Walking Gun Dog National Championship

The 2022 American Brittany Club's Open Walking Gun Dog National Championship was held at the Ionia State Recreation Area in Michigan on October 25 to conclusion. Weather was good running dogs on the first day, rainy on the second day, and cooler on the final day. We appreciate the time and effort of our judges John and Joanne Perry, who spent time in the saddle to determine that NMR Labyrinth Nite Summer Skye, handled by Eddie Manifold, would be the new Open Walking Gun Dog National Winner. Runner-up went to Spring Hills Red Hot Performance, handled by John Bell, 3rd place was Kip's Bay Flat Out Ridge Run-N-Annie run by John Kipp, and handled by Richard Johnson, Alder Zerandipity was awarded 4th place.

Brace 1: Bark River Fresh Water Pearl (Pearl) - Jeff Stanton and Red Granite's Henry Will Be A Star (Henry) - Bob Bakas. Both dogs raced briskly away at the breakaway with Pearl moving to the right side along the tree line with a find at 7. All good. Pearl continued her race forward. Henry running a good race went on point, but had a breach of manners to be picked up at 36.

Brace 2: Magnum High Velocity Top Gun (Gunnar) - Vince Anderson and Sigbrit's Evil Side of The Road (Ren)- Eddie Manifold.

Bird work started early with Gunnar going on point at 2, with Ren coming in for a nice back. All was good . Both dogs raced forward on course. At 6 Gunnar spun around on point, but took a few more steps than the judges liked and was called up. Ren moved around the course at a brisk pace. Coming around the corner a bird was seen flying out of the tree line with Ren in hot pursuit at the 13-minute mark.

Brace 3: Romance's Life of Riley (Riley) – Julie Romence and Parker de L'Etoile du Nord (Parker) – Robert White. Riley was wide ranging and independent in her race. Her first point at 13 was a non-productive. At 36 Riley had another find and all was good. At the start of the orchard, Riley waited a long time for her handler to flush and again all was good. Around the 58-minute mark Riley was up from a delayed chase. Parker's first find was along the tree line before the orchard. After a relocation then flush by Rob, Parker had good manners on his bird. In the middle of the orchard Parker had a non-productive. At 54 at the end of the orchard, Parker had his 3rd find with good manners again.

Brace 4: Over Under Reign the Field (Reign) – Al Cropek and Atos (Atos) – Jackie Hutwagner. Both dogs broke away strong with Atos having his first find in the thick cover on Hires field at 15. Reign came upon Atos on point, stopped, released herself, then backed again to be picked up at that point. Atos had good manners on his bird and was sent forward. After going through Hires field at the opening in the cut Atos went on point at 32, all in order. At the 59-minute mark, Atos was found on point, ending up with a non-productive. He finished going away to the front.

Brace 5: Cedar Glen Disruptin' the Peace (Colt) – Bill Jones and Bantam'n Dr. Jac's Shooter (Shooter) – Mike Magnuson. The brace started with both Colt and Shooter having a stop to flush at the 23-minute mark. Hitting some edges and running a good race Shooter pointed at 39, but took enough steps to be picked up by the judges. Colt backed his bracemate at 39 then was sent forward making some nice moves along the edges. He was really digging in some thick areas and in the middle of the orchard went on point which ended up being non-productive. Moving forward Colt had his final find at 57 with good bird manners.

Brace 6: Dogwood's Moose (Moose) – Christopher Logan and LaPat's Cody (Cody) – Al Cropek. Moose and Cody started out strong on the course. At the 6-minute mark Moose went on point on the right side. Right after point was called, Cody was called back to his handler. Unfortunately, Cody had a health issue and he collapsed. CPR was started and he was revived. Many thanks to Samantha Gauthier and Cindy Cropek for their heroic actions on course. Cody was rushed to the vet where he miraculously recovered. He was retired and lived another few weeks with his owners before succumbing to his heart condition. Our deepest condolences. Moose with all in good order with his bird work, he was sent forward on the course to have his 2nd find along the corn row at 25 with good manners. Running through Hires field and hitting the edges strong, Moose was awarded with his 3rd find at 50. Moving forward Moose finished going away on the course.

Brace 7: Jolly's Christmas Holly (Holly) – Dan Jolly and It's 5 O'clock Somewhere (Cooper) – Rebecca Walters. The brace started with light rain and slightly breezy weather conditions. Downhill from the

breakaway both dogs had a find at 9 minutes with Holly having good manners and sent on. Cooper's find at 9 was to the far-right side of the breakaway all was good. Cooper had his 2nd find at 15 along the curve, sent forward on the course to come across his bracemate on point and was picked up when he failed to back. Holly on point at 21 in Hires field; all good. Another find for Holly at 39 with good manners. Just before the Boy Scout Bridge at 54 Holly is found standing tall, bird flushed, and all is good. Holly sent over the Boy Scout Bridge and slammed on point at 56 with again good bird manners. Going forward on the course Holly finished strong at the top of cardiac hill.

Brace 8: Kozy's Rocky Mountain Gambler (Eli) – Al Cropek and Hall's Baby Girl Madelyn (Maddie) – Shaun Hall. With light rain and wind the brace started with Eli going on point at 4 with good bird manners. Released to go forward Eli stopped to back Maddie who was on point at 5 along the tree line. Both dogs were released forward. Eli pointed at 14 with Maddie now the backing dog. Eli relocated himself, as the handler went in for the flush, and Eli relocated again resulting in being picked up. Maddie going forward on the course had an intense point at 19, manners all good. Moving quickly into the next tree line, Maddie went in, a bird popped up, Maddie then grabbed the bird to end her race for the day.

Brace 9: Pretty Blue Eye A Sweet Touch of Charlie B (Charlie) – Bob Bakas and NMR Labyrinth Nite Summer Skye (Skye) – Eddie Manifold. Brace 9 started with light rain and now sloppy conditions for the dogs and their handlers. At the 6-minute mark Charlie brought his handler a live bird and was picked up. Skye now alone on the course made the most of this advantage with her first find on an edge at 19. Going forward with good manners after the flush, Skye's 2nd find was at 22 down the treeline. Released to go forward quickly Skye had her 3rd find at 27 at the beginning of the orchard. All is good and going forward in the middle of



orchard at 30 Skye was found on point again. Again, all is good. Going forward and hunting hard resulted in another find just outside the orchard at 35. Bird manners very nice. Racing to the front quickly, and working hard, Skye's 6th find at 50 with all good. Released back on the course, Skye racing ahead working some heavy cover on an edge, resulted in her 7th find of a nice covey again with very nice bird manners. Skye finished going away on the course showing us of how a bird dog does it right.

Brace 10: Nalko des Sentier du Ramier (Nalko) – Clint LaFary and Dogwood's Benelli (Benny) -Todd Parmenter. Both dogs were eager to be released and ran forward on the course quickly. Benny went on point at the 5-minute mark, as the bird was flushed a breach of manners occurred and was picked up. Nalko going forward at 8, a bird came up and the chase was on which ended the brace.

Brace 11: Miss Behavin' (Ivy) - Al Cropek and Magnum High Velocity (Gauge) - Vince Anderson. Released just before the Hires



field, both dogs ran the edges through the field very nicely. Gauge went point at the end of the field at 16, good manners were seen. At the 17-minute mark, Ivy went on point, a covey was flushed, and a breach of manners occurred on Ivy's part. Gauge was then released to go back on the course, went back to the same hedgerow of his last point and was picked up for delayed of chase.

Brace 12: Starlight's Mercury Out Ryder (Ryder) – Teresa Richmond and Burning Glen Cover Girl (Lucy) – Mike Mercanti. Ryder and Lucy started on the course fast with Lucy having a find at 10 and Ryder backing his bracemate nicely. All is good and both dogs sent forward. At 20 Lucy went on point ending up with a non-productive. Then quickly on point at 24, with a second non-productive Lucy's run ended. Ryder was sent forward on course with a nice find at 18 just before the Boy Scout Bridge. Released back on the course Ryder at 35 pointed very intensely, with all in order. Ryder another point at 40 all is good, then running fast at 45 Ryder bumped a bird to end his race.

Brace 13: Saradac's Dangeroud Diamon Caper (Caper) – Lisa Pollock and Kip's Bay Fat Out Ridge Run-N Annie (Annie) – John Kipp. Caper and Annie raced forward quickly. At the 7-minute mark Caper brought her handler a bird to end her race. Annie continuing the course had a stop to flush at 26 on the right side of Hires field with the bird lifting on it's own. Just before the Boy Scout Bridge at 38 Annie had her 2nd stop to flush. She ran forward quickly at the end of the bottom of the tree line. On the backside Annie had an intensive point at 48 with good manners. Released Annie raced back on course going forward.

Brace 14: Ramblin Gamblin' Willie (Willie) – Al Cropek and Ace's One Eyed Jack (Jackson) – Donna Janulis. Willie and Jackson released and went quickly on the course with Willie going on point on the right side high on the Derby course at 5 with Jackson backing on a gentle whoa. All good manners for both dogs. Racing forward both went through the cut with Willie moving down the line for a point on the right side at 15. Jackson moving down the line on the left side also going on point at 15. Again, good manners for both dogs. At the 28-minute mark Willie went on point, Jackson backed his bracemate, released himself to go on the course and was picked up. Willie on point, was relocated, ending with a non-productive. Moving on the course at 34 Willie stopped, was relocated twice, bird located and all in order. Running quickly on the course just before the dyke, Willie had an intense very stylish point at 47 with good manners. Released Willie finished the brace strong.

Brace 15: Spring Hills Red Hot Performance (Red) – John Bell and Jolly's Runnin Rylee (Rylee) – Dan Jolly. Red and Rylee quickly raced on the course with Red going on point at the start of the orchard at the 3-minute mark. The bird was deep in the cover, but finally flushed and Red had good manners. In the middle of the orchard Red had his second

find, all good. Racing forward just after the orchard at 12 Red swung around on a very stylish point for his 3rd find. Rylee had her first find at 24 with good bird manners. Racing forward Rylee came across Red on point at 28-minute mark and backed nicely. All was good for both dogs and racing back on the course going strong. Rylee on the right side had her 2nd find; all good. At the same time at 45 on the far-left side, Red had a stop to flush. Going forward on the course quickly and hunting hard Red had an impressive covey find at 55 for his last bird contact for the day. Upon release Red raced forward going strong to the end. At 57 Rylee had her last find with a nice stylish point, good bird manners, released back on the course until time was called.

Brace 16: Alder Zerandipity (Zera) – Richard Johnson and Hall's Baby Girl Sophie (Sophie) – Shaun Hall. Last brace of the day both dogs running forward quickly on the course. At 5 Sophie went on point, bird was flushed, Sophie moved a bit too much for the judges and was picked up. Zera moved quickly along the course and went on point at 11. She was relocated twice, but no bird was produced. Going forward at 19 Zera went on point and was sent on after good bird manners. At 33 Zera had a very nice stop to flush. Sent forward at 33 Zera had a covey find with good manners. Released again on the course, rimming the entire Hires field, Zera was rewarded with a find at 45. Racing forward at 48, on the left edge of the high plateau before the Boy Scout Bridge, Zera slammed on point. Bird flushed, all good manners. - The 2024 American Brittany Futurity shall be open to every Brittany bitch and her progeny whelped during the calendar year of January 1 December 31, 2022, who is owned or leased by a member of The American Brittany Club, and whose litters have been Futurity nominated with The American Brittany Club. Sires do not necessarily have to be owned/leased by an American Brittany Club member. All dams nominated and all sires bred to must be registered with AKC, CKC, or FDSB.
- The nominating breeder needs to be a current full member in Good Standing of the ABC when the litter is nominated and the closing dates of the of the Sectional Futurities in which puppies from their nominated litter compete. They must sign the Litter Nomination form, and any breeder purse checks will be paid to this designated nominated breeder. If their membership has lapsed at the time of the Sectional Futurity, the purse will revert back to the ABC Futurity Administrative Fees.
- Nominations of dams must be made within 60 days after a bitch has whelped, and a Nomination Fee of \$40.00 ("First Forfeit") must be paid at this time. This payment will entitle each puppy of the nominated litter to be entered in the ABC Futurities (Field and/or Show) after the puppy has been properly registered with AKC or FDSB. Nomination Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors.

- Late litter nominations will be accepted with the following current fee schedule: In addition to the Nomination Fee of \$40.00, late fees are \$60.00 (total of \$100) for 61-90 days, and \$100.00 (total of \$140) for 91-180 days. Nominations after 180 days will be accepted at the discretion and decision of the ABC Futurity Committee. The postmark will determine the fee for late nominations. The ABC Board of Directors may impose additional late fees from time to time.
- A Final Forfeit Fee, to be eligible to compete in the Sectional Futurities
 (Western/Central/Eastern), is due by October 1, 2023, and is submitted by
 the owner of the eligible puppy. Futurity Entry Fees will also be paid prior to
 2024 Sectional Futurity events by the owner of the eligible puppy for each
 Sectional Futurity event in which the eligible puppy is entered. Final Forfeit
 Fees as well as Sectional Futurity Entry Fees are set by the ABC Board of
 Directors and subject to change.

Bits About Brittanys by Clarence Goering

The following stories and cartoons have been reprinted from a manuscript that was intended to become a published book. This work was titled "BITS ABOUT BRITTANIES" and was written by Clarence Goering from Newton, Kansas. Clarence bought his first Brittany in 1942 it was a male he named Marquette Allamuchy. He was very active with Brittanies from that point until the 1960's. Being an active, well-known breeder during that era his kennel "TRIUMPH BRITTANIES" was nationally sponsored by Ralston Purina feed company. A copy of this manuscript was assembled into book form and is on display at the Brittany Field Trial Hall of Fame museum in Grand Junction, TN.

A Little Jealousy Goes A Long Way

As humans we are taught to feel that jealousy is bad. Yet I remember when jealousy proved to be of great value in the training of a young dog. Her name was Drip. I called her that because her whole body was white except for three small spots of orange down the middle of her back which looked like someone had dropped three drops of orange paint on her. So the name of Drip seemed very fitting.

She was just a year old when the dove season opened. I had been working with her before the season so the first dove I shot over her on opening day she retrieved like an old pro. When the quail season opened, she showed that she was just a natural as she pointed, backed, and greatly enjoyed retrieving. In fact, she was such a good retriever that after several days of hunting, my buddy Stan and I took her with us on a hunt along the Elk river. We were working along the north bank in some quite heavy cover. The dogs went on point, and as we walked in, several birds flushed. One bird flew to the south and I dropped it. It fell across the river, which, at that point, was about 50 feet wide. To get across would have taken a walk of a quarter mile back down stream. So I said to Stan that if I couldn't get the dogs to swim the river and get the bird, I wasn't going to walk that far for it.

I called Drip, and as she came to me at the edge of the river, I threw a clod which fell in the water near the south bank. I told Drip to fetch, and as she saw the clod

hit the water, she started to swim to make the retrieve. When she got to where she thought the bird had fallen, she couldn't see or smell anything, so she crawled out on the south bank to see if she could find it. Sure enough, she almost immediately found the bird, swam back to me, and delivered the quail to my hand. I patted and praised her and I think she thought the whole effort was really worthwhile. Stan watched the whole thing and jokingly remarked that he was sure Drip had just earned another year of care and board in my kennel.

A few days later, my nephew's old dog died. He needed a dog to hunt with and I sold Drip to him. For the rest of the season she continued to do everything right and he was most pleased with her work. However, the following year when the dove season opened, he had trouble. Drip had lost all interest in retrieving doves. What should be done to correct the situation?

I suggested that he and I go out dove hunting together and take Drip and one of my dogs with us. We went to a water hole and waited for the doves to come in for their evening drink. In a short time, we had shot three birds and my dog retrieved each bird. Drip was close by each time, so when I took the dove from my dog, I spent a lot of time showing him affection with patting and praise. We entirely ignored Drip. This was just more than she could stand. Jealousy got the best of her, and when we knocked down the fourth bird, she really put on an act.

She got to the bird first, picked it up, and carried it back to us as proud as a peacock. Due to jealousy, she learned her lesson well, and for the rest of her life she was a sure fire retriever.

Roc's Points Produce Birds

Oren and I were hunting along an old shelterbelt in which many of the trees had died and had fallen over. Roc was working in front of Oren. He came to the brush of a fallen tree and went on point. I looked at Oren, who wasn't paying any attention to Roc, so I called to him and told him to go up and flush the bird in front of Roc. He said, "There's no bird there. I just kicked that brush and nothing happened. He must be pointing where a bird bas recently flushed." I walked over to where Roc was pointing and when I saw the intensity of his point, I knew he wasn't fooling. I knew he had a bird on point.

So I gave the brush a hard kick and out flew two quail. I aimed at one of them, and just as I pulled the trigger, the other one crossed over into the line of fire. As a result, both birds fell. Boy, Oren was really taken back. He said, "I sure didn't think there was a bird in there, then you come along and two birds flush and you are lucky enough to get both of them with one shot." I laughed, admitted I was lucky, but told him that the next time Roc went on point he had better believe him.

We hadn't walked far when Roc pointed in some real short grass ahead of Oren. I told Oren to get ready but he was so convinced that there was no bird in that short grass that he walked right up to Roc to prove that Roc was wrong. But again, a bird flushed. This time it was a big cock pheasant and Oren just couldn't believe his eyes. These incidents prove the remark I have made many times, "When you think the dog is lying and say there's no bird there; he usually makes a liar out of you."

No Reward, No Retrieve

There is an old argument which I suppose has continued from the beginning of man's hunting with dogs. Some hunters say that when a dog retrieves a quail you should tear off the head and give it to the dog to eat. Other day that this is absolutely wrong because of you feed the dog the head of the bird he will develop into a hard-mouthed retriever and will soon be eating the whole bird before he gives it to you.

When I hunt quail, I sometimes give my dog the head if he has made an outstanding retrieve. However, when dove shooting, I usually always give them the head. I believe this makes them more anxious to retrieve and I have never seen one of my dogs make anything but a soft-mouthed, tender retrieve.

Last fall I had an amusing thing happen when I was dove hunting. It was the second day of the season. I was sitting beside a pond and my dogs, Max and Fonzie, were checking out the grass in the area. In a short time, Max came up to me carrying a dead bird. He gave the bird to me and I immediately knew that it had been shot the day before. It had started to smell so I didn't want to give the head to Max. I held it in my hand while Max sat in front of me in anticipation. I finally walked over to a small tree and placed the bird in one of the branches where Max couldn't reach it. I then returned to the pool.

Borger and his son Jim were hunting with me that evening. They were sitting at another pond about a block away. So when Max didn't get the head of the dove, he went over to the Borgers and spent the rest of the evening retrieving for them. Not once did he come back to me until quitting time. I am sure that if he could have talked he would have said to me, "If you won't give me the head, I'll go retrieve for someone who will." I think I got the message.

In Memory

Frank Pride Jr.

September 15, 1936 – November 18, 2022

Frank Pride, born and raised in Maine, was a dedicated hunter, fisherman and outdoorsman all his life, as well as a Registered Maine Guide. He acquired his first Brittany in 1970, a male he called "Boots" who was a great hunting dog. It was not long after that Frank became involved in the field trial sport. In 1978 he and his friends Dwight "Pete" Jordan and Harry Lisewski founded the Central Maine Brittany Club. Both Pete and Harry passed away several years ago. From that beginning to his death, Frank along with his wife Donna, under the kennel name, Pride and Joy, bred, raised, trained and campaigned several dogs to their Open and Amateur Championship Titles.

Two of his most prominent dogs were 1972

National Champion Aux Aux Mark, and 2003 National Amateur Champion Pride and Joy's Bunch of Annie. Always being Maine residents, Frank and Donna spent winters for several years in Booneville, Arkansas.

His most recent accomplishment occurred a few weeks prior to his passing when his female, Pride and Joy's Kennebago Tommi, finished her amateur field Championship title at the Central Maine Brittany Club field trial in September.

Frank had been fighting cancer for the past several years and at his request, there were no funeral services.

Remembering The Life of a Remarkable Woman Joan Warshefski

1941 - 2022

As I sit here writing, with Brittany magazines, AKC pedigrees, Horse Bill of Sales, and little blips of writings from my grandma, I am brought back to a time when there were whelping pens, horses running the pastures and kennels filled with Brittanies. My adventure into the unique club of bird dogs, hunting wide-open fields and horses, started at KillDee Brittanies with my grandma, Joan Warshefski.

I spent my childhood playing with the puppies from various litters and admiring the horses running in the field, never really understanding their purpose and why they always took my grandma from me every weekend in the spring and fall.

When I was finally old enough to participate in the weekend adventure, I couldn't wait to see what was behind the stories and all the colorful ribbons that made their own wallpaper in my grandma's house.

I don't remember exactly how old I was when I went to my first Field Trial, but what I do remember was never wanting to leave. The hustle and bustle of people on horseback, dogs barking along their stake-out chains as the next dog made their way to the breakaway, and the smile and pure joy on my grandma's face watching me take it all in.







You see, her story in field trialing came long before me, what felt, I'm sure, like a lifetime ago for her. It was her second chance at sharing a passion for the bird dog, and horse.

My grandma began her love for the Brittany and hunting with her father, which continued into her marriage with my grandfather, Harry Warshefski. My grandfather was the love of my grandmother's life; together, they had 2 boys, Paul and Mark, and a remarkable set of Brittanies in Stitch & Chando's White Lightening.

My grandfather left this earth too soon (in 1979), and with that, a void in my grandmother's heart. With her husband gone and heartbroken, Field Trialing was not the same for her. Her watching me fall in love with the sport and all the commotion that came with it helped heal a piece of her and give her a renewed love for the sport she started

with her husband but would end with me.

Joan was a member of the North Jersey Brittany Club and a Lifetime Member of the Susquehanna Brittany Club. She held various roles as President, Treasurer, Field Trial, and Club Secretary. You could always find her in the clubhouse helping with meals and prepping for Happy Hour with her signature 3 berry pie.

She began regularly attending the Nationals in the early '70s through the late '80s. In 2000, she attended with Bob and Barb Youngs to see our co-owned dog, KillDee's Dust Buster compete. I found a Christmas write-up she did that

year, and I want to share in her own words what I believe expresses her pure joy of having been a part of the field trial sport and community.

"It's been 12 years since I have been to the Nationals, so the trip was full of renewed old friendships and marveling at the dogs running in the field. Julie's young dog "Buster" got qualified by winning a 59-dog all-age in Michigan in the spring. Too bad she couldn't make the trip with me to see young Buster run and then snap on-point. So stylish he was, all stretched out and intent. I almost fell off the horse when he went

on point the second time in a difficult situation with the other dog and holding steadfast. The judges posted the best dogs of the day, and I was delighted to see his name on the board; not bad for his first trip to the Nationals!"


Field Trialing ran deep in her blood, and in the many stories shared with me over the years, and now in her passing, I realized



2022 ABC Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

November 19, 2022

Kay-Rodgers Park Fairgrounds, Fort Smith, AR.

Meeting was called to order by Pres. Bob Rankin shortly after 8:00 AM, November 19, 2022.

Executive Secretary Mary Jo Trimble called roll. Directors present in the room were Karen Hanson, Darlene Dow, Vince Anderson, Joe Droel, Bret Ed Tillson, Leslie Masolotte, Mary Brown, Robin Tomasi, Jim Hammett: Present on video hookup were: Tom Bass, Ron Gulembo, Jim Stevens, Burton Wice, Bruce Heiter, and Brett Lindback. All Directors were in attendance and a quorum was achieved.

Motion 1: Motion to seat new members was made by Lindback and seconded by Hammett Motion: I move to seat the new members elected in 2021. They include Leslie Masolotte, Jim Stevens, Bruce Heiter, for 3 year terms and Karen Hanson and Tom Bass to fill unexpired terns. All Yes, Motion Passed.

Pres. Rankin asked for a round of applause for Robin Tomasi for setting up the video equipment for the meeting.

Motion 278: Motion by Lindback, seconded by Hammett to approve the 2021 Board Meeting Minutes. All 15 yes, Motion Passed.

The BOD then moved through the list of Agenda Items and reports. If no one had questions or discussions, we moved on to the next one after any questions were recognized.

First discussed was by Secretary Trimble dealing with the new AKC Championship applications. She pointed out some of the problems with wording that AKC and ABC had encountered on the new forms. AKC has granted us 60 Championships. She asked the BOD if the BOD wanted to establish rules for who can apply for Championships if they were not already approved in the past. She also pointed out that if the American Field Championship Associations cannot run under a Regional Club, then they either have to run as an ABC sponsored event or an AKC Specialty Club. Currently only the New England Championship is the only Specialty Club. Specialty Club events and dates still have to be approved by the ABC and Regional ABC Dates Coordinators. Dogs will be qualified for the ABC Nationals and awarded AKC points for FC Titles. The BOD took no action.

Mary Karbiner, statistician, was in attendance and came to the microphone to present her report and answer questions. Mary was complimented by one of the Directors for the huge amt of work she puts into those stats and received an applause.

Sec. Trimble discussed National Animal Interest Alliance and Sportsmens' Alliance and how they help us with National legislation. Question was asked if ABC Foundation could donate. Finance Chair Judy Graves responded that was not feasible from the Foundation which has very little money at the present time.

Director Droel brought up the new AKC rules regarding Derby Stakes and was opposed to this. This was discussed as well as that Field Trial Secretaries are not responsible for dogs being entered correctly. AKC rules state that the Owner is responsible. Some felt if they act as agent that they are responsible even if the written rules say "owner". No action taken as this is an AKC rule no matter who promoted it.

Director Tomasi discussed her proposal regarding having a presence on Instagram. Director Hanson recognized two ladies Haley & Libby who came up with this proposal.

Motion # 3: Motion by Lindback, Seconded by Hanson I move that the Board move forward with a motion to approve the addition of an ABC Instagram page, change the name of the Facebook Committee to Social Media Committee, and to update the Facebook policy to add Instagram. Policy can be found on pages 28 - top of page 31 of the 2022 Agenda Book. Add highlighted content. All 15 Yes: Motion Passed. (Agenda book can be found on ABC website and in the ABC magazine.)

Finance Committee Chair Judy Graves presented and explained her Financial Report and Budget proposal. Discussion went on for a considerable length of time. Event Budgets will be sent out in March since National Events are just now happening. We do have money in reserve to cover any shortfalls we may have this year. Several suggestions were made by Directors to be added or changed in the budget.

Motion # 4: Motion by Tillson, Seconded by Hammett. I move to accept the budget with proposed changes .. 5 YES Votes (Bass, Wice, Lindback, Tillson, Hammett; 10 NO Votes (Hanson, Dow, Anderson, Gulembo, Stevens, Heiter, Masolotte, Brown, Tomasi) Motion Failed. President asked what changes would it take to pass the budget. Nothing was brought forth but may be in executive session.

Finance Chair Graves also presented 3 names to be appointed to the Finance Committee. As this involved individuals and the Chairman, a decision was postponed to be discussed in Executive Session.

Nancy Clendenen asked that the BOD add the National Walking Open and Amateur Championships be added to the Dual Dog Points Award. She also asked that 3 points for any Champion just showing up be removed again as it was in the past. This part of the proposal was postponed till the summer meeting when Nancy will have a new schedule worked out to present to the BOD.

Motion # 5: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Brown. Motion: I move to add both National Open and Amateur Walking Gun Dog Sstakes be added to the Dual Championship Award schedule using the same point schedule as the horseback Gun Dog Stakes. (Schedule on page 27 of 2022 Agenda Book) All 15 yes votes. 0 No votes. Motion Passed.

Motion # 6:: Motin by Dow, Seconded by Tomasi. National Open and Amateur walking gun dogs who placed will be counted on the point scale for the 2022 Dual Dog Award. 14 YES Votes, 1 NO Vote (Lindback) During the Futurity Discussion, Statistician Mary Karbiner asked that she be notified of both show and field results by the secretary of each futurity.

Motion # 7: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Droel: Motion: I move that in the Policy Book Futurity Secretary Duties #10 that the Field and Show results be sent to the ABC Statistician. Page 116 of policy book. All YES 15 Votes, 0 No Votes, Motion Passed.

Magazine Review Committee Chair Karen Hanson. She said her charge was to look at ways to make the magazine better. I am not charged with or trying to kill the magazine. She discussed results of a survey and other things she and her committee had looked at. This was a very lengthy presentation by the Chair. She will reach out to see If our website has the capability to have a members only section where current magazine could be posted rather than having a printed copy mailed. Chair Hanson said she would come back in February with some recommendations from her Committee. They would then be voted on at a summer meeting. The Executive Secretary was asked to reflect this in the minutes.

Discussion of Policy Book Housekeeping change. Current Policy Book Duties, Item 7, page 168.

Motion 8: This motion related to deleting all of item 7 and reporting to the BOD every change in the policy book. That Motion was withdrawn and replaced.

Motion: # 9: Motion by Lindback, seconded by Wice. Motion: I move to delete current item 7 in its entirety and replace with: All changes including House Keeping changes to the ABC Policy Book except for spelling and numbering errors should be approved by the ABC Board of Directors. The approval can be made during a Board meeting or by email. (See page 25 of Agenda Book). 14 YES Votes and 1 NO Vote. (Gulembo).

Hammet questioned the policy of how to fill vacancies If a person not elected Page 25 Agenda Book Action Item # 2 does not have 33 1/3rd percent. Motion 9A by Hammett, Seconded by Wice that Directors from that region will nominate 2 candidates and a Regional election shall be held. Secretary Trimble quoted By-laws which state how vacancies can be filled. BOD shall appoint the replacement. Motion was withdrawn.

10 minute break.

New Directors elected by the membership were announced by President Rankin. East Coast Linda McCartney, East Central Vince Anderson, Central Burton Wice, Midwest Brett Lindback, and West Coast Helen Riggle.

Motion on 20 minute derbies qualifying for Invitational Derby: Motion by Hammett, Seconded by Tomasi. Motion: I move that for 2023 and all future years, the point calculation for the Derby Invitational shall include any horseback derby run for 20 minutes as follows. Ist-4 points x dogs run, 2nd 3 points x dogs run, 3rd 1 point x dogs run. The hour and 45 minute stakes are left the same. 12 YES Votes, 2 NO Votes (Wice and Lindback), 1 Not Voting (Bass). Motion Passed. Hammett went on to explain that the majority of AKC Derbies are 20 minutes in length.

Masolotte's Action items # 5, 6, 7 page 26 of Agenda Book can be handled without Motions. # 8 on the 5 minute rule needs to be clarified.

Motion # 11: Motion by Masolotte, Seconded by Dow. I move that the judging of the ABC Field Futurity Section of the ABC Policy Book, page 188 "The five minute out of judgment rule, and the judges are so advised: be clarified. Remove this highlighted line since AKC rules apply.) 15 YES votes, 0 NO votes, Motion Passed.

Motion dealing with DNA & Invitational Derby: Motion by Hammett, Seconded by Tomasi. Motion # 12: I move that all dogs entered in the ABC Derby Invitational must have an AKC DNA profile on record with the AKC. The DNA # must be included on the event form or if placing will submit to the field trial secretary within 6 weeks. 15 YES votes, 0 NO votes Motion Passed.

Secretary Trimble said this was not considered a National Championship nor are the Game bird Classics or Regional AKC Championships. They are considered AKC stakes that all breeds must run under the same rules. The AKC Vice President can allow other provisions on the 6 (SIX) Parent Club National Championship Field Trials and the National Specialty Show which are considered NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS WHERE SPECIAL EXCEPTIONS CAN BE MADE. {The BOD did not accept this for the Invitational Derby which is an hour AKC Derby Stake and passed the motion #12, but postponed any decision on the Classics and Regional Championships.)

Motion on Nat. Specialty Trophy. Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Tillson. Motion # 13: I move that the BOD increase the amount allocated to the ABC Summer Specialty host club for Best of Breed from \$75 to \$150, and Best of Opposite from \$60 to \$120. All 15 YES Vote, ONO Votes, Motion Passed.

Motion # 14 on ABC Primers: Motion by Dow, Seconded by Hanson. Motion: I move that we tell the Magazine to stop printing the ABC Primers and direct people to the website for a copy. All 15 YES votes, ONO Votes. Motion Passed.

Motion # 15 National Specialty Show: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Hanson,. I move to add to the last line of the Show Fund Allocation paragraph on page 32 of the Agenda Book the following: In the event of a loss, an amount of 25% of the loss incurred will be will be deducted from the show projects fund. 11 YES votes, 4 NO votes (voting no: Droel, Lindback, Masolotte, Bass).

Motion # 16 Separation of the Breed. Motion by Hanson, Seconded by Anderson. Motion: I move to discuss a possible separation of the French and American Brittany. All 15 YES Votes, 0 NO votes, Motion passed.

A lengthy presentation and possible proposals by Director Droel and President Rankin was put forth to the Directors. They felt they needed more information that if we split would the French Clubs be ready to become a Parent Club meeting all the requirements by AKC. They would like another Committee Appointed to look into this and present the information in 2023 BOD meeting.

Motion # 17. Breed Separation vote: Motion by Hammett, Seconded by Anderson. Motion: I move that ABC not recommend to AKC at this time to split the breed into American Brittany and Espanuel Breton 10 YES Votes, 5 NO Votes. (Hanson, Droel, Masolotte, Tomasi, Brown voting No)

Motion # 18: Motion on Laundry at Boonville Grounds: Motion by Tillson, Seconded by Droel. I move the ABC purchase a commercial coin operated washer and dryer for the laundry room at the Booneville property. Funds to come from the Special Grounds Fund not to exceed \$3,500. 14 YES Votes, 1 NO Vote. (Wice voting no)

Motion # 19: Position Statement on EB and American Brittany split: Motion by Hanson, Seconded by Tomasi, I move the ABC recognizes that the Epagneul Breton Breed and the Brittany are separate breeds in the United States and abroad, and we discourage crossbreeding amongst the two distinctly different breeds. 8 YES Votes, 7 NO Votes. (Bass, Dow, Anderson, Wice, Lindback, Tillson, Hammett voting No. Motion passed.

BOD then went into Executive Session. On return to the general meeting, the following was announced as passed in Executive Session.

Officers Elected: 1st Vice President: Richard Beaver; 3rd Vice President Joy Crisler; 4th Vice President Mike Poehler; Recording Secretary Jacqui Campbell; Executive Secretary Jennifer Brooke Burlingame.

Appointed to the Finance Committee: Bruce Heiter, Mary Karbiner, and Brett Lindback. No announcement of any vote yes or no on the ABC Budget was announced.

No people were nominated in time for the People Hall of Fame. No Dogs put forth by the Committee were elected by the BOD for the Dog Hall of Fame.

Thirty one dogs came to the line for the 2022 running of the ABC Prairie Chicken Championship. All thirty one of them came with their running shoes on. Each and every dog brought to the line at breakaway left with gusto and continued though out the hour or as long as the Prairie Chickens would let them. This is truly an all age stake with all age dogs competing for the title. The sandhills of Nebraska with its prairies and hills are the perfect background for this wild bird championship, only one of two in the country for our breed. This year's bird population was in abundance and provided some exciting finds for our Brittany's.

Judges for this year's running were Cynthia Findley of Ventura, lowa and Howard Burback of Pleasant Hill, MO. Both experienced judges and handlers, themselves, they were most attentive and had no problem arriving at the winners. We welcomed professionals Tom Tracey, Ed Tillson and Chad Holman. They were joined with amateurs Kent Patterson, Richard Beaver, Joe Williams, Stan Truksa, and Dan Campbell. We were also happy to see Mary Karbiner return from her year off.

None of this could happen without the cooperation of the town of Bassett and its surrounding landowners. The Rock County landowners, Ted Morton, Butch Fischer, Curtis Luther and Wade Dearmont have long provided the bird dog world terrific prairie grounds in Nebraska. Sponsors Purina & Tri-Tronics also continue to contribute their products for the winners and financial support from Purina for the club. Without their support, these types of field trials could not happen. Kent Patterson provided the Polaris UTV to pull the dog wagon. When you think of Prairie Chickens, you first of all, think of Claudia & Stan Truska who put this all together. Without them and the Nebraska Brittany club, this event would not happen. Claudia was the dog wagon driver with Stan taking the course marshal duties. Between Stan and Tom Maneely,

gates were opened and closed for all the handlers, judges & gallery. Claudia also picked up donuts provided by Jeanna Harman who runs the Coral Bar in Bassett for our morning breaks. We missed having Ray Trimble here who was our normal donut person.

GARMIN.

This year mother nature showed us how versatile she could be. Monday morning started off comfortable, but quickly became warm but windy. Tuesday was much the same, but heat didn't seem to bother the dogs as the handlers, kept them hydrated with all the water tubs placed strategically on the course as well as the windmills in place by the landowners to support the cattle production. Finally, the weather broke, with Wednesday's temperatures 30 degrees cooler.

Handled by Tom Tracey, our winner, CVK's Spartan King, came from the 9th brace. It was 45 minutes until we got to the honey hole where a lot of the prairie chickens were hanging out. Leo was found on point at the fence line when 7 chickens blew up in front of him. When Tommy released him, Leo had a stop to flush just a few minutes later in front of him which really fired him up. He finished the hour with a very strong final 12 minute run. We all knew he was the dog to beat. Too bad his owners Jack & Crystal Alexander couldn't be there to enjoy his performance.

The Running:

Brace 1) JJ's Levi the Lionheard (Levi) Joe Williams & Countyline's Full Throttle (Mac) Stan Truksa started the event with Levi establishing point at 5 minutes and then moving on. Before Joe could get to the area where Levi first pointed, 2 birds got up and he was credited with a stop to flush. At 54 minutes Levi could not let the covey that lifted in front of him fly away and he was picked up. Mac had a face to face with a ranch dog after he wondered into the front yard of

the rancher's house at :18. This took his mind off his work at hand and Stan elected to pick up at 34.

Brace 2) PineyRun Patch, Kent Patterson, and My Lit Classic Mercedes, Richard Beaver. As with all the braces run, both dogs broke away strong. Patch bumped 4 birds and was sent back to the wagon. Richard Beaver ran the hour but had no bird contact.

Brace 3) Mr. Staley, Frank Campbell & Jagoub's Spell Caster (Tabu), Tom Tracey. Tabu had a stop to flush on a big covey at the start of the big bail hay field. Heat was starting to take its toll and Tom picked him up at 26. Just a few minutes before, Mr. Staley chased two birds as they got up. He tried to stop, but took a couple too many steps to be credited with a stop to flush..

Brace 4) After lunch, Ed Tillson brought J&M Rodeo Romeo to the line with Chad Holman bringing Black Creek Whizki Skip. Romeo had a non productive at :10 with Skip backing. Ed deciding to pick him up. After his back, Skip had bird contact with a stop to bump making for a short brace.

Brace 5) The temperature was getting hotter However, the dogs remained strong as they were finding adequate water on the course. Piney Run Senor, Patterson & Jac's Ray of Sunshine, Holman. Ray was picked up @ :40 with 2 steps after a stop to flush along the fence. Time was called for Senor at the end of the hour with no bird contact.

Brace 6) The last brace of the afternoon started at 3:00 p.m. sharp. Stan Truksa running Countyline's That Guy and Richard Beaver running Arrow's Tequila Rustler were saddled with running at the hottest time in the afternoon. Both dogs did not let the heat get to them. Guy ran the lines and showed what a true all age dog should be. Unfortunately, by that time the birds had left the course looking for cooler land. While Rus found a cool pond next to the windmill, he soon discovered that green stuff was not solid ground. He jumped several times thinking he was on hard land. When he finally got out, he was covered in green scum and then picked up lots of stickers running up the hill. Richard picked him up at :21.

Brace 7) Tuesday was a bit warmer than Monday. Our judges reminded the handlers to think of their dogs first, before they worried about stopping for water too often. Jagoub's Whodat Say Whodat when I say Whodat with Tom Tracy and Black Creek Bell II with Chad Holman. Whodat established point at :48 but self-released himself as no birds were near. Tommy was off his horse at 8:55 without any birdwork. Whodat's owner Tom Jagelski was on board scouting for Tommy. Chad had Bell running a really good race but no birds were to be found.

Brace 8) Gangster's Secret Weapon (Sniper) with Chad Holman and Almaden's Under Lock & Key, Ed Tilson both broke away going to the front .At :6 Ed's dog chased. Sniper at :35 had a bird on the run but didn't stop long enough as the bird lifted. Owners Ed & Donna Janulis were there to watch the action.

Brace 9) After a break for those good Bassett home made donuts & coffee, CVK's Spartan King (Leo), Tom Tracy and Wingra's Lindy-Go! (Ed Tillson) broke away at 9:55 a.m. Both dogs took off like they knew exactly where to go to find the birds. Wingra pointed at :12 but took a non-productive. At :16 he bumped a bird and was picked up. Meanwhile, Leo was putting on quite a show. At :45, point was called as six or seven chickens came roaring out of the fence line, while Leo stood staunchly. Then just a few minutes later he had a stop to flush which really fired him up, finishing the hour as strong as he started.

Brace 10). Cedar Valley Luke, (Tom Tracy) & Piney Run Jake, (Kent Patterson). The heat was really taking its toll as both dogs were picked up early.

Brace 11) Wild Willie. (Ed Tilson) ran as a bye. He ran strong for the entire hour but was not able to produce any birds.

Brace 12) CVD's Jungle Land ((Tom Tracy) and Piney Run Hill Top Blew (Kent Patterson). The first 15 minutes of this brace saw the two dogs staying really close to each other. Finally, at :15, Tommy picked up and took his dog back to camp. Blew continued with Kent off his horse four times to no avail. We all went back to camp hoping for cooler weather Wednesday, but pleased with Leo's performance earlier in the day.

Brace 13) Wednesday brought cooler temperatures as promised. Prairie Wind Pistol Pete (Tom Tracy) and Gangsters Jezabelle (Jazz), Chad Holman. Both dogs broke away strong, enjoying the cooler weather. Jazz was the first to establish point at :19. However, he had to take a non-productive. At :50, Pete established point and as Tommy flushed, 2 birds got up with all in order. At :51, Jazz knocked a bird which may have come from the Pete's find.

Brace 14) Tonan-Roa Just Because It's Clear Cut (Ed Tilson) and Black Creek Summit (Chip), Chad Holman. Rao broke away at 9:05 with a 4-bird find at 9:06 with all in order. 15 Minutes later he had a stop to flush with a step too many. Chip had a strong forward race and established point in the hay bale field. Unfortunately no birds could be produced.

Brace 15) Piney Run Zack, Kent Patterson and JWB's Artic Cat (Kimber), Tom Tracy. After a short coffee break, we broke away at 10:35 a.m., not realizing we would be looking at the second and third place dogs of the event. 10 minutes into the brace, Zack pointed a covey of 4-6+ birds with Kent flushing and Zack looking as staunch as could be as the birds went everywhere. He had a non-productive at 24. At :44 and :50 Kent removed stickers from Zack's paws which did not slow him down a bit. He finished strong with this exciting covey find under his belt. Meanwhile, Kimber had her first find of 4-5 birds at :6. With all in order Tommy took her on to a second find of 1 bird at :11. She was off to the left covering a lot of ground at pick up time.

Brace 16) Hoochie Cooch Man (Hooch), Ed Tillson and Roustabout All In (AI), Tom Tracy. The final brace of the event broke away at 10:45. Hooch was picked up for chasing the bird Al had for which his stop to flush was credited at :05. Not pleasing his handler, Al was picked up at :34, thus ending this ABC Championship.

For those of you not attending, you missed a remarkable performance by all the dogs entered.

Arcadia Wildlife Management Area

The New England Brittany Wild Bird Championship is run at the Arcadia Wildlife Management Area in Exeter, Rhode Island. This state owned Management Area of 12.000 acres is controlled by the state of Rhode Island departments of Forestry. Parks and Recreation and Fish and Wildlife. The habitat is rolling New England woodland, a lot of which is overgrown abandoned farm land interspersed with meandering cold water trout streams and ponds. The area is located about ten miles inland from the southern New England Atlantic seashore. The weather in this area is a lot milder than further inland and north towards Massachusetts, Vermont, New Hampshire, and Maine. The northward bound spring migration of woodcock tend to stage in this area for a few weeks during late March and early April, waiting for the weather to get milder to the north so they can continue on to their summer breeding grounds in northern New England and the Canadian Maritime Provinces.

Wild bird championships began running on these Arcadia grounds in the early 1980's. During those early years the trials were run around the Labor Day weekend. In spite of the warm weather at that time of year, the seven one-hour courses were all laid out along the cold water trout streams. The dogs were always within a couple of minutes of the cold water and the temperature along those streams was always several degrees cooler because of the forest overhead cover. These early fall events were run on wild birds that were native to the area When that native bird population began to decline, the trials were then moved to the spring. For the last fifteen years that the trials have been run in the spring, there has always been sufficient amount of migrating birds available, and in some years, way too many. To run wild bird field trial events you have to go where the birds are available in sufficient numbers to create a level playing field where all dogs have an equal opportunity.

The Almighty Water Hose

The pups are five weeks old as I start writing this piece. Feeding is twice a day; their mom is only with them at night. Within the next several days, pups will be without their mom – weaning completed and on their own. Because it is summer with warm temperatures, pups have spent all their early days in an outside house in a kennel runway.

Cleaning of the kennel runway is usually accomplished when pups are outside the kennel feeding. However, there are times it is necessary to clean when the pups are in the kennel. Water spray is never directed toward pups, but there is splatter that occurs. Oh, how quickly they learn to avoid "get out of the way" from the spray. It comes to the point that when the water-hose is picked-up for cleaning, they move quickly into their house.

At this early age of five weeks, pup's learning process is like a sponge. At this age, exposure is important to as many different situations as possible. Noises, people, kennel crate, riding in a vehicle are a few examples.

There are five Brittany pups in this litter. As they feed from a large round dish, metal pans are slowly brought together – not too loud at first – as pups become use to the noise, the intensity is increased.

Several times a week there are two families with eight to ten year old kids that are playing with

the pups. Even their parents are holding the pups. Before the pups were weaned from their mom they were picked-up and held to get them use to human touch.

During this time at the early age – five to seven weeks – pups are loaded into a kennel crate for brief rides. Also there will be one or two trips to the Veterinary's office for shots and health exams. This type of exposure is so important. All of these experiences – riding in a vehicle, being with people, and exposure to the kennel crate – make for what is known as socialization.

Now the litter of five pups - 12 weeks old - is down to two. Three have gone to new homes, one of the pups in a couple of weeks will be going to its new home in Florida, and the fifth-one will stay with me. She has been selected because of the litter's breeding. In addition she of all the pups has shown a degree of separation from the others - first to the food dish and runs independently.

A week later, these two remaining pups were given their first exposure to birds; pigeons were used for their initial contact. The pigeon was held by its legs with wings flapping over the pups. Bird released and allowed to fly-off with pups in "hot" pursued. The same procedure then repeated with four more pigeons. More of this type of exposure to birds will follow along with introduction to gunfire. Pups have already been conditioned to loud noise with the metal pans and food dish. Pups will be 50 yards off in pursued of the flying bird before the blank pistol is fired.

It is always a great experience with a litter of pups from the time of whelping to when they mature into a bird finding gundog; hunting, field trial or bench show champion. From the first exposure to the "water hose" to chasing the flying pigeon, and moving onto a "finished" gundog, it is a glorious adventure.


