- 1. Qualifications for the 2005 Championships (always a topic)
- 2. Continue holding All Age Championships at Booneville 2005-2007.
- 3. Review of recently implemented AR Fish & Game procedures. (Ron Zook, Pres.)
- 4. Discussion of Club's financial report and related issues. (Janet Chase, Trea.)
- 5. Election of Officers (Nominating Committee, Dr. Bob Rankin, Chair)
- 6. HOF for distinguished members vote on 2nd ballot (Ron Zook, Pres.)
- 7 Formation of a Regional Club in North Dakota (Don Padgett of ND)
- 8. Suggestions for AKC's Pointing Breed Advisory Committee Meeting next Spring. A. One topic suggested so far is an AKC Master Nationals Event for Pointing Breeds. B.
