What will be your strongest asset as a member of the BOD and why?

I've served on numerous boards and committees in my career and understand the importance of listening and understanding other's perspectives. I also appreciate the need to make decisions and get past debate once perspectives have been heard.

As a retired federal land manager, I've advocated for regional clubs that are using federal land for trials. In the face of increasing restrictions, we've been successful retaining grounds on terms favorable to our clubs. Retaining field trial grounds will continue to be an issue both at the regional and national level. I have learned much in the last 10 years and think I can be an asset with this aspect.

The western region is the largest of the five ABC regions, both in terms of geography and numbers of members. Many of the ABC decisions made at a national level have an impact on our members, whether that is location of national events, or other aspects that are of western concern. One of my primary objectives would be to ensure that the concerns of the west are represented, well-articulated, and understood before any decision is made that affects us. If elected, I will represent the interests of the western region, not my own.

I believe that the Brittany is first and foremost a bird dog. I average over 50 days hunting with my Brittanys each year. I've recognized for a long time that demographic changes do not favor field trialing, yet it is very important for the Brittany breed to figure out ways to continue field events to "keep the hunt in the Brittany."

Finally, I believe strongly in the dual-dog concept of ABC and believe it needs to be enhanced in a positive manner through greater recognition and awards for dogs that excel in both the show ring and the field.
