- **\*\*NEW\*\*** All handlers are required to buy an Arkansas small game hunting license. Available at Walmart in Booneville or [Hunting License Descriptions and Fees • Arkansas Game & Fish Commission \(agfc.com\)](#)  
Non-resident \$80 for 5 days, \$110 yearly.
- **Entries Close:** Mon., **November 10** at 7:00 PM (EST) at Field Trial Secretary, 116 Reservoir Rd., Ft. Edward, NY 12828. Entries requiring a signature for delivery will **NOT** be accepted.
- **Drawing:** Drawing will take place Wed. November 12 at 2:00 PM (EST) at AKC 8051 Arco Corporate Dr. STE.100, Raleigh, NC 27617. Only one alternate handler allowed on entry form. Bracing will be available after the drawing.
- **DNA:** All dogs entered in the ABC National Championships must have a DNA profile, either permanent or temporary, on record with the AKC or Field Dog Stud Book. The DNA number must be included on all entry forms. All Dogs born 1/1/24 or after **MUST** have AKC DNA.
- **Horseback Handling:** Permitted in all stakes.
- **Bitches in Season:** To be declared the day of running.
- **Firearms:** Blank Ammo & Solid Barrel Guns Only!  
209 Primer or .32 caliber blanks must be used.
- **Retrieval Collars:** Permitted in accordance with current approved AKC guidelines.
- **Roading of Dogs:** Not allowed on the course.
- **Campsites, Kennels & Stalls:** Available Saturday, before start of Nationals. Kennels are reserved for judges and contestants only. Stalls will be marked for judges. Camping with electric is available for a daily (\$15) fee OR without electric for a daily (\$10) fee.
- **Motels:** Countryside Inn - (479) 675-4900; Paris Inn - (479) 963-2447, Mt. Magazine Lodge- (877) 665-6343
- **Horse Wrangler:** Not provided by ABC.
- **Coggins Test:** Verification required for all horses.
- **Hay:** will be available for \$8.50 per bale.
